

Important Traffic Safety Alert

It has come to our attention that some illegal parking situations are occurring on Appian Way, also known as “the top of the stairs”. These situations are dangerous to our students and a nuisance to the neighbors.

Cars are “double parking” and even “triple parking” at drop off and dismissal times. It is against the law to pull up next to cars that are parked at the curb and have your child exit or enter the car from the street. You must pull to the curb to drop off or pick up your child. This means that on Appian Way you may have to stop farther up the sidewalk where there is an open spot to pull along the curb. If you want your child dropped off or picked up closer to a school entrance, it is suggested that you use the front of the school.

Another dangerous situation is that students are darting across the street instead of using the sidewalk. Students must use the sidewalk and follow it around the cul-de-sac on Appian Way. Crossing in the middle of the street is dangerous. Children are hard to see when they come out from between cars and we don’t want a tragedy to happen to any of our precious children.
