

School Traffic Safety

If you are driving your children to and from school it is very important that you follow the traffic safety plan listed below:

- ★ **Share rides** with other families to reduce the number of cars around each school.
- ★ **Leave a few minutes early** and allow plenty of time before drop-off and pick-up times. Give your children their money, school papers, hugs/kisses before they get to school.
- ★ **Use the school's circulation plan** and designated drop-off and pick-up areas.
- ★ **Do not park in red zones** or in front of residential driveways. Park legally, even if it's further away from the school grounds.
- ★ **Do not double park** (stopping in the traffic lane) to drop off or pick up your child.
- ★ **Drop-off/pick-up your children** at safe locations. Do not pick a place where your children must cross through traffic. If they do need to cross a street, have your children use the intersections or crosswalks especially with crossing guards.
- ★ **Do not make U-turns** near the school or turn around using a private driveway.
- ★ **Obey the 25 mph speed limit** in residential/school areas, all traffic signs and school crossing guards.

Be Courteous To The Neighbors

- Drive slowly (25 mph).**
- Do not block or park in private driveways.**
- Do not leave trash or move trash cans.**
- Teach your children to respect the neighborhood's private property.**
- Always be polite to other drivers and children.**
